Conyers, GA - Rockdale County Public Schools has launched the Microsoft IT Academy in each of its high schools to provide students the opportunity to earn industry recognized credentials before graduating. This program is available to all students in Rockdale County through a partnership with the Georgia Department of Education and Microsoft.

The Microsoft IT Academy provides every high school student with the future-ready technology skills they need to be successful in college and a career. In the state of Georgia, there are more than 8,000 current, open, advertised jobs that require Microsoft technology skills (indeed.com, December 2012).
